Dress Code for Meetings and Educational Virtual Sessions

PROFESSIONAL AND RESPECTFUL ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALA CO GIRLS STATE/Virtual.

ALA CO Girls State is a highly selective program. Each day is scheduled with specific meetings and guests to the program, including sponsors and speakers, who frequently interact with citizens and staff. Consistent with those high expectations and our public visibility, please dress accordingly.

Dress to be successful!!...EVEN ONLINE!!

Appropriate attire:

- Dresses, skirts, dress pantsuits, dress slacks or dress capris with professional tops are the expectation unless otherwise indicated in the schedule.
- Dress/skirt length must be a modest length, slightly above the knee or longer.
- Tops must be tasteful and cover one's torso, revealing neither stomachs nor breasts.
- Remember: Pictures will be taken and posted on Facebook/website for all to see.
- Leggings worn under skirts or dresses.
- Make sure that your surroundings are appropriate for business meetings.

Inappropriate attire:

- Clothing that is backless, see-through, tight-fitting, has spaghetti straps, is strapless, off the shoulder, extremely short or low-cut
- No shorts, rompers, or shortalls
- No denim blue jeans, denim skirts or jeggings
- Visible undergarments including bralettes
- Leggings worn as slacks.
- No pajamas or loungewear (daytime or nighttime)

IN THE EVENT THAT AN ALA CO GIRLS STATE CITIZEN, JUNIOR COUNSELOR, COUNSELOR OR STAFF MEMBER IS INAPPROPRIATELY DRESSED, AS DETERMINED BY A CITY COUNSELOR OR THE DIRECTOR, THE YOUNG LADY WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE CLOTHES. THE CHANGE IN ATTIRE WILL OCCUR BEFORE SHE IS ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DAY'S ACTIVITIES.
