Application forms will be posted on the Department Website: www.alacolorado.com (Due June 9, 2022)

Qualifications:

- An ALA member who is in good standing in her unit or someone who is eligible for membership.
- Someone interested in guiding and leading the ALACGS program.
- Someone willing to dedicate time and service to the program.
- Someone who has experience serving at ALACGS.
- Must fill out the Leadership application found on the Department website.
- Someone who can commit to serving the full session at the upcoming (2022) ALACGS program.

Duties: (complete list is in the Procedures Manual, page 13.)

- Serves as Chairperson of the ALACGS Operations Committee.
- Selects session theme, song, and city theme, with approval of the Operations Committee.
- Schedule, plan, and run the training for ALACGS staff.
- Organize speakers and presenters. Reviews all written material, gains approval from committee and submits them for printing by May 1st.

How can I prepare to become an ALACGS Director? How can I get Involved?

1. **Apply to serve** at the upcoming ALACGS session.
2. Be sure you are a member in good standing of the American Legion Auxiliary.
3. Attend all the trainings and learn about a counselor's or staff member's responsibilities at ALACGS. When you are ready, fill out the application.
4. If you attended the program in the past either as a delegate or a staff member, apply to return.

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
